

KENTUCKY HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION

April 2, 1930

The Board of Control submits the following proposals for changes in the rules for the consideration of the members at the annual meeting April 16th. For the most part they are not fundamental, but merely to clarify the meaning, in line with established precedent based on rulings and interpretations.

CONSTITUTION

Article III, first line: Add the words "or accredited" after the word "approved".

Article VII, Section IV, second line: Change "February 1st" to "January 15th".

Article VIII, Section I, at the end: Add the words "that is eligible for membership".

TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

Rule 3, first line: In place of the words "during the last week in January" insert "on or before January 15th".

At the end of Rule 3, add the following: "No telegraph or telephone votes shall be counted. No vote when once mailed can be recalled or changed. No vote shall be counted which is received by the secretary later than midnight January 25th. In case of a tie vote the Board of Control shall decide in a manner to be determined by the Board which of the tied schools shall hold the tournament."

Rule 5, third line: Change "January 15th" to "January 1st".

Rule 9, first line: Change "the last week in January" to "on or before January 15th".

Third line: Change "upon receipt of this list" to "on or before February 1st".

Fourth line: Strike out "within two days".

BY-LAWS

Rule V, first paragraph, amend so as to read as follows: "A student to be eligible during any semester must have been in attendance at school at least three months of the preceding semester of the school and must have passed for that semester in at least three full-credit high school studies, or have made up any deficiencies in that amount of work, in accordance with the established custom of the school within two weeks after the beginning of the next term."

Add a fourth paragraph as follows: "A student is permanently ineligible for athletics in this state if he transfers from another state later than twenty days after the beginning of a school year in which, or at the end of which, he would have become ineligible in the state from which he transfers, unless parents move with him."

Rule X, second line: After the words "graduate from a", insert "four year".

Rule XII: The first sentence of this rule should be amended to read as follows: "If a player enters a contest under an assumed name, or when not properly certified, he shall be permanently ineligible, and his school shall forfeit the contest and shall be suspended from membership for the remainder of the year."

Rule XIV, second paragraph, second line: After "filed" add "in writing".

Amend the last sentence of this paragraph to read as follows: "When a player is declared ineligible, all games in which he has played while ineligible shall be forfeited to the opposing teams, except that this shall not apply to tournament games."
