East Eligibility Committee Minutes

The East Eligibility Committee met at the K.H.S.A.A. Building on Thursday, November 29, 1979, at 9:30 A.M., to hear an appeal in the eligibility case of J. L. Woods, a student at Oneida Baptist Institute ineligible under the provisions of By-Law 6, Section 1, Transfer Rule. Committee members present were Chairman Jack Burkich, Zeb Blankenship, Norman Passmore and Joseph McPherson.

Mr. Mills reported that he had sent copies of all the correspondence in this case to members of the Committee; Mr. Burkich then introduced J. L. Woods, his parents and Larry Gritton, Coach at Oneida Baptist Institute.

Each person present for the appeal was given an opportunity to address the Committee. They asked that By-Law 6 be waived in favor of J. L. Woods due to the fact that he changed schools because of problems he had encountered with the coaching staff at Leslie County High School. Members of the Committee explained to Mr. Woods that his problems at Leslie County High School were of a local nature over which the K.H.S.A.A. has no control.

Following the appeal and a discussion thereof, Norman Passmore moved, seconded by Zeb Blankenship, that K.H.S.A.A. By-Law 6, Section 1, Transfer Rule, not be waived in this case. The motion passed unanimously.
