The East Eligibility Committee met at the K.H.S.A.A. Office Building, Lexington, Kentucky, on Tuesday, October 4, 1988, for the purpose of hearing an appeal from Mr. Joseph LaMonica, on behalf of his son, James. Members present were Chairman Pearl Ray Lefevers, Marvin Moore, David Points, Tony Olinger and Ken Tippett. Commissioner Mills and K.H.S.A.A. Board Attorney Danny Reeves were also in attendance.

The Committee heard the testimony of Mr. LaMonica and comments from his attorney, Mr. Steven Vicroy. Following a question and answer period and a lengthy discussion, Marvin Moore moved that the ruling of the Commissioner be upheld in this case. Tony Olinger seconded the motion and it passed by a vote of 5-0.
