


K.H.S.A.A. WEST ELIGIBILITY COMMITTEE


The West Eligibility Committee met at the Executive Inn East, Louisville, Kentucky, on Thursday, June 28, 1990 for the purpose of hearing an appeal on behalf of Kent Browning. Members present were Huston DeHaven, Sam Chandler, Sandy Allen and Charlie Miller. Commissioner Mills and Executive Assistant Billy V. Wise were also present.

Kent Browning had been ruled ineligible to represent Trinity High School in interscholastic athletics for a period of thirty-six school weeks following his transfer from Ballard High School. The ruling was based upon the fact that Principal Sandy Allen, Ballard High School, had indicated on the transfer form that Kent was transferring for athletic reasons. Her decision was based upon comments made by Kent and his father prior to the change of schools by Kent.

Present to represent Kent were Mr. and Mrs. Earl Browning, Kent and Attorney Schuyler J. Olt. Following comments made by each representative and questions by members of the Committee, Sam Chandler moved, seconded by Charlie Miller that the ruling of the Commissioner be upheld in this case. The motion passed 3-0. Sandy Allen left the room and did not cast a vote.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
