STATE SOCCER THIS WEEK

The 2006 KHSAA Boys' and Girls' State Soccer Tournaments are slated for this Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday, Nov. 1-2 and 4 at Toyota Stadium in Georgetown. Girls' semi-finals are scheduled for Wednesday at 6 and 8 p.m. Boys' semi-finals are scheduled for Thursday, also at 6 and 8 p.m. Saturday the girls' championship begins at 6 p.m., followed by the boys' championship at 8 p.m.

General Admission will be \$7 each per night. An All-Session Ticket (general admission for all three nights) will be available for \$15 each. Children under 6 will be admitted free. Gates Open at 5 p.m. each night.
