Board of Control of the Kentucky High School Athletic Association at the Kentucky Hotel, Louisville, on Saturday morning, December 1956. The meeting was called to order by President Russell Williamson at 9:30, with all Board members, Commissioner Theo. A. Sanford, and Assistant Commissioner J. B. Mansfield present.

Dawson moved, seconded by Louis Litchfield, that the reading of minutes of the October meeting be waived, since the members of Board had received copies of these minutes. The motion was carried unanimously.

Member W. B. Jones of the Trophy Committee reported that his committee, meeting at the K.H.S.A.A. office on December 1, had accepted the low bid of The Sutcliffe Company for the 1957 district and regional basketball tournament trophies. He stated that there were only two bidders, The Sutcliffe Company, and Hunt's Athletic Goods Company, and that the Sutcliffe bid was some \$300.00 less than the Hunt bid. The actual bid price of Hunt was \$2508.88, and the total bid price of Sutcliffe was \$2209.10. W. H. Crowder moved, seconded by Cecil A. Thornhill, that the action of the Trophy Committee be confirmed and approved. The motion was carried unanimously.

B. Mansfield gave a report on the 1956 regional and state cross country runs. He stated that it had been possible to set up three regional meets this year, with three teams being qualified from each regional affair for the state run, and that it was hoped that enough interest had been created for additional regional meets to be conducted next year.

There was a discussion concerning the naming of a speaker for the forthcoming annual meeting of the Association. Director W. B. Jones and Commissioner Theo. A. Sanford were authorized to make an attempt to secure the services of a good speaker.

Commissioner discussed briefly several problems which had arisen in connection with the forthcoming State Tournament, and stated that preliminary plans had been completed, including ordering the tickets.

President Williamson named K. G. Gillaspie and Supt. Frank Ogden of Chester to membership on the State Swimming Committee. The membership of the committee is now as follows: Chairman Alfred M. Reece, W. Craik, M. J. Cavana, K. G. Gillaspie, Frank Ogden, and Theo. A. Sanford.

Litchfield moved, seconded by Robert Forsythe, that the next meeting of the Board be held in Lexington on Saturday, February 2. The motion was carried unanimously.

B. Jones made a report on the present retirement program for the Commissioner and Assistant Commissioner, pointing out several flaws that exist in the present arrangement. He was asked to continue with the survey and study.

Litchfield moved, seconded by K. G. Gillaspie, that all bills of the Association, beginning October 20, 1956, and ending December 21,

1956, be allowed. The motion was carried unanimously.

The Board was then called to order in its capacity as Board of Directors of the K.H.S.A.A. Protection Fund.

Chairman W. H. Crowdus of the Insurance Committee asked that Jack Dawson be added to the committee, along with Commissioner Theo. A. Sanford, serving in an ex-officio capacity. President Williamson made these appointments. Mr. Crowdus reported that the committee was accumulating material from several commercial companies, and that it might be necessary to have one or more additional committee meetings between Board meetings before a complete report could be made to the Board of Control.

Secretary-Treasurer Sanford presented a list of claims which had been paid since October 20, 1956, the total amount of these claims being \$7,108.09. Jack Dawson moved, seconded by W. H. Crowdus, that the claims as presented by the Secretary-Treasurer of the Protection Fund be allowed, and that a list of the claims be made a part of the minutes of the meeting. ^{The motion was carried.} The claims are as follows:
