


By Action of the Board of Control on July 30, 1977, Todd Shadowen was declared ineligible to represent Madisonville-North Hopkins High School in athletics until he has been enrolled there for a period of thirty-six school weeks beginning with the last time he participated in an athletic contest at Madisonville - North Hopkins High School in violation of the rules and regulations of this Association.

The meeting was called to order by President Ray Story at 11:00 A.M. Present were Board members Denvil Barriger, Zeb Blankenship, Jack Burkich, Joseph McPherson, Norman Passmore, Glendon Ravenscraft, and George Sauer; Commissioner Tom Mills, Assistant Commissioners Louis Stout and Dianne Caines. K.H.S.A.A. Board Attorney Calvert T. Roszell and Mr. and Mrs. Lige Shadowen were also present.

President Story explained the reason for the special called meeting and asked Mr. and Mrs. Shadowen to present their appeal. Following their presentation and several questions by members of the Board, Mr. Story thanked Mr. and Mrs. Shadowen for their presentation and assured them a decision would be made as soon as possible and they would be notified by the Commissioner. Mr. and Mrs. Shadowen thanked the members of the Board for their time and departed.

Following a lengthy discussion, George Sauer moved, seconded by Paul Trimble that the appeal to reinstate the eligibility of Todd Shadowen be denied. The motion passed unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
