The East Eligibility Committee of the K.H.S.A.A. Board of Control met in special session on Wednesday, September 9, 1987, for hearing appeals on two eligibility cases. The following members were present: Chairman Tony Olinger, Bill Case, Ken Tippett, Frank Welch and Charlie Wilson. Commissioner Tom Mills and Assistant Commissioner Billy V. Wise were also present.

Mr. and Mrs. Jim Barnes appeared before the Committee to request that the Commissioner's ruling on the eligibility status of their son, James David Barnes, be reversed. James David was ruled ineligible to represent Henry Clay High School in interscholastic athletics following his transfer from Millersburg Military Academy.

Following the presentation of Mr. and Mrs. Barnes and a discussion thereof, Ken Tippett moved, seconded by Charlie Wilson that the ruling of the Commissioner be upheld in this case. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0 with one abstension.

The decision was based upon the fact that James David Barnes did not qualify for a waiver of the rule under any of the guidelines provided within the rule.

Then the following persons appeared before the Committee on behalf of John Hall, a student who transferred to Harrison County High School from Fleming-Neon High School and was declared ineligible under the provisions of the transfer rule: Mr. John Hall, Sr., Ms. Bonnie Collins, Ms. Billie Fryman, Coach Ray Graham and John Hall.

Following presentations by the above listed individuals and a discussion thereof, Ken Tippett moved, seconded by Charlie Wilson that the ruling of the Commissioner be upheld in this case. The motion passed unanimously.

Again, the decision of the Committee was based upon the fact that John Hall did not qualify for a waiver of the transfer rule under any of the guidelines provided within the rule.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
