MINUTES

MEETING OF THE BOARD OF CONTROL HELD IN LOUISVILLE
JUNE 22ND, 1930

Districts were arranged as they will be printed in the 1930-31 Tournament Regulations.

Concerning the Minerva-Morehead transportation question: President O'Donnell said that he understood that Mr. Allison was to pay his auto drivers only what he collected from Morehead. The secretary was directed to write Mr. Allison to see whether he had paid the drivers more than he had collected from Morehead; if not, further consideration of the matter is deemed unnecessary; but, if he did have to make up the difference, he is asked to send the secretary a receipted bill for the amount paid.

It was also decided that the following note shall be printed in the new booklet following Tournament Regulation 4: "Traveling expenses mean expenses actually incurred for transportation, but in no case shall they be greater than standard bus, or taxi, or train fare, which ever is cheaper. Receipted bills for transportation expense must be presented to the tournament manager in order to be allowed".

It was decided that the principals of suspended schools shall be required to make a special agreement to abide by the rules before reinstatement is allowed; no reinstatement fee is to be charged.

Vice President Brown said that he had a sufficient supply of stationery; President O'Donnell needs a supply of small envelopes and letter-heads.

The printing contract was awarded to the Eve Printing Company.
