Kentucky High School Athletic Association Regional Off-Limits

BENTON, KY (March 20, 2014) – Size limits will be announced at the rules meeting and will be in accordance with the size and catch limits established by Kentucky Fish & Wildlife. To view your area's catch and size limit, please visit www.fw.ky.gov for more information.

Region 1 – Lake Barkley: The following areas are off-limits to fishing:

- All waters west of the Hwy 453 Bridge (you can fish the bridge itself, but not beyond)
- All waters south of the Hwy 79 Bridge (you can fish the bridge itself, but not beyond)
- Any marina marked no fishing by the marina operator
- Any area marked no fishing by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers

Region 2 – Herrington Lake: The following areas are off-limits to fishing:

- Chimney Rock Marina
- Any marina marked no fishing by the marina operator
- Any areas marked no fishing by Kentucky Utilities or the EW Brown Generating Station

Region 3 – Lake Cumberland: The following areas are off-limits to fishing:

- Conley Bottom Marina
- Any marina marked no fishing by the marina operator
- Any area marked no fishing by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers

Region 4 – Cave Run Lake: The following areas are off-limits to fishing:

- Cave Run Marina
- Any marina marked no fishing by the marina operator
- Any area marked no fishing by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers
