Note: The totals in Row 4 for girls and in Row 8 for boys must be the same as the totals in Form T-1, Column 3, Rows 1 and 2 respectively.
- 3) For Column 3, list the number of interscholastic teams that have been added in the last five years at each competitive level. Count each team added during the 5 year period only one time. e.g. Girl's junior varsity soccer was added 3 years ago, count the team only once, not 3 times. For girls, total the entries in Rows 1, 2, and 3 into Row 4. For boys, total Rows 5, 6, and 7 into Row 8.
- 4) For Column 4, list the number of participants that are currently on each level of the teams that were added in the last five years. If a team was added previously but no longer exists, there are no current participants to be added for that team. For girls, total the entries in Rows 1, 2, and 3 into Row 4. For boys, total Rows 5, 6, and 7 into Row 8.
- 5) For Column 5, calculate the percentage of participants that have been added in the last five years. For girls, take the number in Column 4, Row 4 and divide by the number in Column 2, Row 4. For boys, take the number in Column 4, Row 8 and divide it by the number in Column 2, Row 8.

Note: If the percentage of current participants added in the last five years is 25% or greater, compliance with test two may be possible. If less than 25%, then compliance with test three should be analyzed. <u>CAUTION</u>: 25% is <u>not</u> a formal compliance standard.

Determine the total number of interscholastic athletics participants that are girls, (and place in Row 1, Column 3). In order to determine the total number of athletics participants, an individual should be counted each time he or she participates on a team. For example, if Jane Doe competes on the varsity volleyball team, the junior varsity basketball team, and the varsity softball team, she should be counted as four participants (**do not include club or intramural sports participants**, **cheerleaders**, **dance teams**, **or pom sqads**). Calculate the same way for boys and girls. * In addition, should 8th grade students and below play on a Freshman, Junior Varsity, or Varsity team, they should also be counted for each team and sport on which they participate. If applicable, please asterisk the above notation as to how many 8th grade students & below are included in the totals. Using the same procedure, determine the total number of interscholastic athletic participants that are boys, (and place in Row 2, Column 3). Add Row 1, Column 3 plus Row 2, Column 3 to get total participants and place in Row 3, Column 3.

5) Calculate the percentage of female participation. (Row 1, Column 3 divided by Row 3, Column 3 and place in Row 1, Column 4.)

Calculate the percentage of male participation. (Row 2, Column 3 divided by Row 3, Column 3 and place in Row 2, Column 4.) Note: Row 1, Column 4 plus Row 2, Column 4 should total 100%.

Note: While being within three percent is <u>not</u> a formal compliance standard; if the percent listed in Row 1, Column 4 is within 3% of Row 1, Column 2, then it provides a good target within which compliance is likely.
