According to data submitted, the school is currently meeting the standard established in both Test #2 and Test #3 for provision of the athletic opportunities. In the benefits area, athletic spending is far outside of acceptable parameters for the past school year. According to data submitted the school is spending approximately \$686 per male athlete as compared to approximately \$453 per female athlete for provision of athletic benefits. This situation should be addressed by school administrators with all deliberate speed. School officials are again reminded that the KHSAA requests that the Gender Equity Review Committee have student representatives.
