E.	X	<p>Other Recommendation and Comments: According to calculations submitted, it is likely that the school is meeting the standard established in Test 1 for the provision of athletic opportunities. The responses given on the T-3 form indicate that the standard established in Test 3 is also being met, however, compliance with Test 3 does not appear likely at this time because there is no evidence that the indicated interest in girls tennis (19) has been pursued. In the area of benefits, total athletic spending appears to be outside acceptable parameters (approximately \$773 per male athlete compared to approximately \$440 per female athlete). This disparity appears to be addressed in the school's Corrective Action Plan. Athletic spending should be closely monitored so the disparity does not continue over a two-year period.</p>
