		The Gender Equity Committee meetings are to be held three times a year but often there is need to meet more that this. When only three meetings are held during a year it is recommended that they be held during the three sports seasons (Fall – Winter – Spring) so that coaches in each of these respective seasons can have input with the committee.
V1 .		 The Gender Equity Committee needs to keep documentation in the yearly report as to why there is such a difference in the number of teams and/or coaches in softball/baseball. The Gender Equity Committee needs to address that no travel expenses are listed for five sports. Traveling for free is a good thing but hard to believe or understand. Overall spending is good when comparing per-male and per-female spending. NCC is spending \$261.37 per male athlete and \$177.49 per female athlete.
