According to data submitted, the school is meeting the standard established in Test 1 for the provision of athletic opportunities. If the school takes further steps to address the indicated interest in girls track, it will likely meet the standard established in Test 3. In the area of benefits, total athletic spending seems to be outside of acceptable parameters for provision of parity on both a percentage and per athlete basis. <u>School officials should closely monitor this spending so this disparity does not continue over a two-year period.</u> School officials are also encouraged to add two student representatives to the Gender Equity Review Committee as designated in the Corrective Action Plan.</p>
