X	Other Recommendation and Comments: According to data and responses submitted by the school and corrected by KHSAA representatives, it appears the school is meeting the standard established in Test 3 for the provision of athletic opportunities. This standard is being met because of the school's efforts to address the indicated interests on the most recent student athletic interest survey as documented on the T-3 form. In the area of benefits, total athletic spending is far outside of acceptable parameters for provision of parity on both a percentage and per athlete basis. This disparity has now continued over a two-year period. <u>School administrators and the Gender Equity Review Committee should address this issue. The school's Corrective Action Plan needs to document the steps that are taken to provide equitable benefits to the school's athletes.</u>

**Plans to Address Interest: The Athletic Director and I held a meeting on 4/1/10 encouraging students who filled out the student participation survey to attend a meeting after school on each of the above sports. Only four students were in attendance at the meeting for all of the above activities (1- tennis, 1- skateboarding, 1- rugby, 1 rifle). Due to the low student turnout on 4/1/10, we held another meeting after school on 4/12/10. For this meeting, only three students attended. The breakdown of interests follows: one male student wanted to participate in rugby, and one female and one male student wanted to participate in tennis. None of the other sports were represented. Based on the aforementioned data, one can conclude there is not a sincere interest among our students creating new athletic teams. Furthermore, we currently struggle to maintain a full team of female soccer players ( a team we created five years ago).**


