Plans to Address Interest: In last year's survey, there was an interest in both girls and boys tennis and girls and boys soccer and football. We are planning a meeting in the fall to see if there enough true interest in tennis and soccer for boys and/or girls. We do not feel that we have enough participants that would sustain a football program at this time.




