In the area of benefits, the reported athletic spending falls outside the acceptable parameters both on a percentage and per athlete basis (\$845.00 per male athlete spending compared to \$641.00 per female athlete). The variance should not exceed \$100.00. This should be reviewed and monitored by Administration and the Gender Equity Committee so as to insure equity for all sports and reflected in future Corrective Action Plans. Thank you.

- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- 3) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
- 4) Ask coaches to confirm the names of those individuals who are on the team as of the first **date of regular season competition**, and cross out the names of those who were cut from the team or quit the team prior to the first regular season competitive event. Determine the total number of interscholastic athletics participants that are girls, (and place in Row 1, Column 3). In order to determine the total number of athletics participants, an individual should be counted each time he or she participates on a team. In our last survey (2010) we had 435 students fill out the survey. Only three sports had over 10% students want to play a sport not offered: Archery 11%, Rifle (11%), and Gymnastics (16%). We have been exploring a Swimming team (boys and girls) and starting Bowling (boys and girls). Swimming we have had 2 meetings to discuss adding this sport, and plan to have another meeting in the Spring. For bowling, it is a club sport now but we do plan to have a varsity team for boys and girls next year if interest is there.
