- 1) Determine the total number of girls enrolled, (place in Row 1, Column 1). Determine the total number of boys enrolled, (place in Row 2, Column 1).
- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- 3) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
- Ask coaches to confirm the names of those individuals who are on the team as of the first **date of regular season competition**, and cross out the names of those who were cut from the team or quit the team prior to the first regular season competitive event. Students were told that this was a interest meeting as Allen county has NO bowling Alley in our county or within 25 miles. Very few of these students have ever bowled and none on a team of any sort.

A second Bowlign interest meeting was held for both players and parents on Wed. April 24th at 4;30 pm CST in the High school library. the meeting was announced several times and emails went out. 0 were in attendance for the meeting. Coach Harwood was present but no one showed for meeting.


