- 1) Determine the total number of girls enrolled, (place in Row 1, Column 1). Determine the total number of boys enrolled, (place in Row 2, Column 1).
- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- 3) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
- Ask coaches to confirm the names of those individuals who are on the team as of the first **date of regular season competition**, and cross out the names of those who were cut from the team or quit the team prior to the first regular season competitive event. 5. Describe your plans to address interest below:

The following actions were taken by Danville High School Title IX Committee to pursue the interest in woman's golf and bowling further.

- 1. During the fall of 2012, an additional survey was conducted to see if interest in either or both sports was still present. The survey was conducted in grades 8-11 of females. 80% of girls enrolled in those grades returned the surveys. (See attached survey)
- 2. Of the girls surveyed, 11 girls expressed interest in golf and 35 girls expressed interest in bowling. On the survey, girls were asked to include their name so that they could be contacted with further
- 3. After the survey was completed, the Title IX school chairperson and Assistant Athletic Director explored area schools that currently have golf and bowling programs. The following information was discovered:
- a. Most of the adjoining county school systems do have golf programs for women.
- b. No area schools currently offer bowling programs for women.
 4. Danville High School had previously offered a women's golf program, but due to lack of interest it was dropped. (When it was dropped we had one female participating and she graduated, and no new girls were interested at the time.) It should be noted that there is still money allocated by the board of education for a women's golf coach and if interest in starting that program again were to occur, it would be added to the current roster of women's sports.
- 5. After gathering the information of those interested, a personal letter was sent to each girl that had expressed interest to inform them of a meeting to further explore the possibility of adding women's golf and bowling to the current sports offerings. (Letter attached)
- 6. The meeting was scheduled for after school on March 19, 2013 in the DHS cafeteria. No students attended the meeting.
- 7. With no one showing interest in attending the meeting to explore adding the new sports, the option to reinstate golf if interest were to occur, and no other local schools with current bowling programs to compete against, the Danville High School Title IX committee feels that the interest in these sports is only on paper and will not at this time pursue these matters further.
