Coach's Comments

What are keys to your team's success in winning the tournament:

We are a team with only 3 seniors on the roster (Bale, Scott and Slone), so they will have to lead by example. We have 3 players making their 3rd trip (Scott, Bale, Matney) and 4 more making their 2nd (Hughes, Corbin, Sidebottom, and Vaughn) to the state tournament in the last 5 years so they know what to expect and have to keep our younger players relaxed and focused. Also, have we can't afford to give any extra outs. We need for our 5,6 and 7th hitters (Corbin, Vaughn and Slone) and our two 8th grade starters (Judd and Hedgespeth) to keep coming through for us like they have most of the year. If we can limit our mistakes and give Mony and Majestee some run support I think we will make a deep run.
