However, the KHSAA staff is permitted to use its judgment in reviewing sites that were constructed prior to the adoption of these standards and is expected to make exceptions where necessary. Particularly important is the need for possible exceptions in situations where the facility is "landlocked" or otherwise limited in moving items such as the outfield fences or the backstop distances. While it is desirous of the Softball Committee to have all facilities meet all of the specifications, the Committee recognizes that some existing facilities have held successful KHSAA postseason events for many years.
