But her contributions were in the area of Spirit and Cheer. She coached (actually started) the gymnastics program at Bryan Station in 1962 and the Track program at the school in 1964 where she coached those sports until 1974. She was varsity cheer coach from 1962 to 1980, and was the Sweet Sixteen® Champion coach in 1972 and 1974.</p> <p>She was one of the primary leaders in KAPOC and continues in that role today. She joined in 1962 and has served as President, Vice President, 17 years as a Regional Chairperson and has been a member of the Advisory Board for more than twenty years. She was also a co-founder of the Kentucky Girls Sports Association and remains active today as the founder and President of the Bryan Station Alumni Association.</p> <p>She also remains active as the coordinator of the state at-large cheerleading competition, handling the facility management aspects and setting up the venue as she has done for more than 10 years.</p> <p>She is a past winner of the NFHS Spirit Award and was a recipient of the 2004 UK College of Education "Teacher Who Made a Difference" Award in 2004.</p>
