## MARTY DONLON

Marty Donlon began his coaching career with his return to his alma mater, St. Xavier, in 1963 after graduating from Bellarmine University, where he attended on a golf scholarship, winning the conference individual championship in 1957. After serving two years in the US Army he joined the basketball staff of long time friend Joe Reibel as assistant basketball coach and head golf coach. During these forty years the St. X golf team has won sixteen State Championships, twenty-two Regional Championships. The dual record during that time was 1165 wins and 61 losses. Marty was NHSACA National Coach of the year in 1981, NFICA National Coach of the year in 1995. Marty has been inducted into four Hall of Fames, Bellarmine University in 1986, St. Xavier 1992, National High School Coaches in 1996 and the Metro Area Athletic Directors in 2002. Marty has been the assistant manager and manager of the State Golf Tournament for forty years. He has been a Regional golf manager for thirty-nine years. He founded and is the director for the All State Golf Teams for boys and girls. He also started the East-West Junior All Star basketball sponsored by the KHSCA in 1987. Marty was President of the KHSCA 1982 to 1984, National Vice chairman for Golf for the NHSACA for twenty years, a member of the Board of Directors for the NHSACA from 1982-1984. Co-founder and director of the KIT golf tournament, the longest continuous high school invitational in Kentucky high school, celebrating its 40<sup>th</sup> renewal this year. Marty was also the head basketball coach at St. X when they won the Ashland Invitational in 1977. Marty and his wife, Pat, of forty-three years, have five daughters and nine grandchildren.
