

Charles S. Joseph was sports director during his tour of duty with the US military, serving both state side and Europe.

Charles played successful football and baseball most of elementary and high school.

During Charles' military career he officiated football and baseball. Upon retirement from the military service Charles ^{settled} with family in Radcliff, Kentucky. Charles saw the need for a baseball officials association. This meant the formation and training of baseball empires. Through contact with the Kentucky High School Athletic Association the task was begun and TRI state officials association was started under the direction of Charles S. Joseph. Duties included recruiting to become baseball empires, officials were trained to cover this region and the state baseball tournaments. The training was started at Ft. Knox, Kentucky.

Charles has retired as TRI state officials association Executive Director in 1989. Charles is pleased with the progress of the association as the organization continues to move forward.
