She played 6 years of softball, earning all-district honors as a 7th grader. She is a 6-time all-district performer, 2-time all-state selection and was voted Kentucky Miss Softball as a senior. She finished her career as the state's all-time leader in triples (28), was second all-time with 15 home runs and third all-time with 149 RBI. She batted .549 during her junior year and finished her senior season with a .523 average. She is a 5-year varsity basketball player, scoring more than 1,000 points during her career. Marnitz was a 2-time all-district selection and twice was named all-city. She wass a 6-year varsity golfer. She won the Ky. Women's State Am 3rd flight as an 8th grader. She won several tournaments during her career and helped lead Dunbar to a state championship during her junior season, and a state runner-up finish as a senior. Marnitz also played 2 years of varsity soccer.

During her career at Dunbar, Marnitz finished with a 3.7 GPA and won several academic awards, including her induction into the National Honor Roll, Who's Who Among High School Athletes, and won the Wendy's High School Heisman trophy for Kentucky in 2003.

Brooke Marnitz earned a scholarship to play softball at Kentucky, where she was an outstanding All-SEC performer. She still holds several school records for hitting.
