

She was a standout performer in softball for six years; was a standout basketball player for five years; played six years in golf; lettered two years in golf. During that time, Brooke earned numerous honors, including the title Miss Softball in 2003; regional softball POY in 2002, 2003; All-region and all-city basketball in 2002, 2003; led her golf team to a state runner-up finish in 2003, while earning all-region honors; was all-city tournament in soccer in 1999.</p>



<p>Please summarize this person's accomplishments as a coach, player, official or contributor at the high school level in Kentucky.</p> <p>Brooke Marnitz is one of the most decorated female athletes in state history. She holds a record 19 letters while playing 4 sports at Dunbar. She played 6 years of softball, earning all-district honors as a 7th grader. She is a 6-time all-district performer, 2-time all-state selection and was voted Kentucky Miss Softball as a senior. She finished her career as the state's all-time leader in triples (28), was second all-time with 15 home runs and third all-time with 149 RBI. She batted .549 during her junior year and finished her senior season with a .523 average. She is a 5-year varsity basketball player, scoring more than 1,000 points during her career. Marnitz was a 2-time all-district selection and twice was named all-city. She was a 6-year varsity golfer. She won the Ky. Women's State Am 3rd flight as an 8th grader. She won several tournaments during her career and helped lead Dunbar to a state championship during her junior season, and a state runner-up finish as a senior. Marnitz also played 2 years of varsity soccer.</p> <p>During her career at Dunbar, Marnitz finished with a 3.7 GPA and won several academic awards, including her induction into the National Honor Roll, Who's Who Among High School Athletes, and won the Wendy's High School Heisman trophy for Kentucky in 2003.</p>
