Biography for Tom Steltenkamp

Tom Steltenkamp was 1980 graduate of Ft. Thomas Highlands High School where he lettered as a student athletic trainer for Coach Bill Hermann and his football teams; Coach Ken Shields and his basketball teams and the late Coach Bob Luecke and his track teams. He was part of numerous winning teams including the 1977 KHSAA Football AAA Championship and the 1979 Region 9 Basketball Champions.

With the help of Bill Hermann and a trip to the Kentucky East / West All-star games he was introduced to Jerry May, former Head Athletic Trainer for the University of Louisville and was offered a four year athletic scholarship to the University of Louisville. He was a student athletic trainer for all the athletic teams in addition, to working with Hall of Fame coach, Denny Crum.

After graduating from the University of Louisville in 1985, he worked one summer in the minor leagues with the St. Louis Baseball Cardinals in Savannah, Georgia. While finishing his summer in baseball he received a call from Jerry May and the late team physician for the University of Louisville, Dr. Rudy J. Ellis. They wanted him to expand their athletic training coverage to the Louisville area and surrounding counties.

With their guidance, Tom helped provide sports medicine / athletic training coverage for Jefferson County athletes for twenty years which included the first outreach sports medicine program to high schools in this area. He has provided medical coverage for all KHSAA Championships that are held in Jefferson County. He has also helped organize the KMA / KHSAA Coaches Medical Symposium for the past twenty years. In addition, Dr. Ellis wanted him and Jerry May to educate the high school student trainers with camps and symposiums. Numerous student athletic trainers received scholarships to college to pursue sports medicine careers.

Mr. Steltenkamp has been very active with the Kentucky Athletic Trainers Society. He has served as the President, Vice-President and Secretary for the organization. He has also served on the executive committee for the Southeastern Athletic Trainers Association.

He has had some individual awards bestowed on him which include the 1995 recipient of the KHSADA – Dr. Rudy J. Ellis / Distinguished Service Award. In 2000, he was the recipient of the Southeastern Athletic Trainers Association Clinical Athletic Trainer Award and in 2004 was inducted into the Metro Athletic Directors' Hall of Fame.

Tom continues to provide sports medicine and athletic training coverage to area high schools and special events in addition to his duties of administrator for Ellis & Badenhausen Orthopaedics, P.S.C. and the Dr. Rudy J. Ellis Sports Medicine Center in Louisville.
