# IT'S SHOWTIME!

TV - MERCURY LIGHTING/LIVE SHOTS

Television "live shots" are to be conducted prior to or at the conclusion of each session. ABSOLUTELY NO MERCURY LIGHTS ARE TO BE POINTED IN THE DIRECTION OF THE PLAYING FLOOR FROM ANYWHERE WITHIN THE ARENA WHILE PLAY IS IN PROGRESS.

INTERVIEWS.

Locker rooms and the back hallway are closed to the media during the tournament. Following a brief cooling off period after each game -- five minutes -- the winning coach and selected players will be escorted to the interview area. The interview room is located in Room 112 of Diddle Arena. The losing coach and players will follow. TV stations wishing to do one-on-one interviews will be afforded the opportunity AFTER the coaches/players visit the interview area. These should take place outside the player/coach entrance to the interview area.

ABSOLUTELY no interviews, especially radio, are to be conducted on the floor immediately following the conclusion of the game. All coaches/athletes MUST report to the interview area prior to doing any post-game radio/TV interviews.

**WEEKLY PAPERS** 

Due to space limitations, weekly papers are asked to rotate seating during games involving teams from their coverage area. A reserved press row seat for the entire tournament is not available to weekly media outlets. Four seats on press row will be marked "Weekly Papers". You may sit in these seats during your game, but to accommodate others, we ask that you return to the auxiliary seating third row of press tables following the game.

NON-ORIGINATING RADIO

Radio stations that are not originating a broadcast of the tournament are to utilize auxiliary press seating as marked on the third row of the press row tables. There are no reserved seats for non-originating radio stations on press row.

**PARKING** 

Parking passes may be picked up on a first-come, first-served basis, at the Tournament Headquarters or when you sign in the first day. The lot is first-come, first-served.

RESULTS

Results, including box score and play-by-play from each game, will be available in the media workroom. Results will also be posted on the KHSAA internet site (www.khsaa.org). For complete tournament coverage, the KHSAA has again partnered with iHigh.com and kentucky.com to provide real audio, pictures, game footage, recaps, and other information. MEDIA WORKROOM/HOSPITALITY

Room 104 of Diddle Arena will again serve as the media workroom. This is located to the right of the interview room. Courtesy phone lines are available on a first-come first-served basis to transmit. Please be considerate of other outlets with regard to the use of phone lines.

Meals for working media members will be served in the workroom.

**ADVANCE TICKETS** 

Advance tickets, priced at \$6 in the school pep section (End Zone) will be on sale immediately following each team's game. Those tickets will be sold in room 220 of Diddle Arena. Tickets purchased afterwards, at the gate, will be priced at \$7 each for endzone seats.
