TOURNAMENT HEADQUARTER

The KHSAA Tournament Headquarters is located in Salon A at the University Plaza/Holiday Inn in Bowling Green. You may call the headquarters at (270)745-0088. The headquarters will be open Tuesday (8 a.m.-6 p.m. CT), Wednesday and Thursday morning from 8:30 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. All issuing of credentials on Wednesday and Thursday will take place at Entrance 3 (Media Will Call) at Diddle Arena. Credentials will not be issued at Headquarters after Tuesday.

TITLE SPONSOR

This is a reminder that Houchens Industries remains the official title sponsor of the Girls' Tournament. Houchens is in the ninth year of its sponsorship and will remain the title sponsor through the 2011 event.

Finally, please remember the official tournament reference is Houchens Industries/KHSAA Girls' Sweet 16® Tournament or Houchens/KHSAA Girls' Sweet 16® State Tournament and should be used by outlets credentialed by the KHSAA for the event. Simply referencing the event as the "Sweet 16®" is incorrect.

MEDIA CREDENTIALS

Credentials to the 2011 Houchens Industries/KHSAA Girls' State Basketball Tournament are non-transferable. Credentials are issued in the person's name in which it was granted (photo identification required) and is valid for one day only. Media members will individually sign in at Media Will Call each day. Please notify tournament headquarters or a member of the tournament staff if there is a name change in a credential request.

PRESS ROW - PHOTO PASSES

Press Row and the scorer's tables, as well as areas marked for photographers and videographers are reserved for working media only. Do not sit in seats which are designated for other outlets. Seating charts are posted throughout floor level for your reference.

ABSOLUTELY no cheering, coaching or clapping (or contesting officials' calls) will be permitted in working media areas. Those members violating this policy will lose all press row privilege and possible access to future KHSAA events.

50th HOUCHENS INDUSTRIES/KHSAA GIRLS SWEET 16 SET TO BEGIN IN BG

For the 50th time in state history, regional winners from across the state of Kentucky will come together in Bowling Green, Kentucky with the ultimate prize on the line, the 2011 Houchens Industries/KHSAA Girls Sweet 16 State Basketball Championship.

QUICK FACTS

- The 2011 participants are a combined 402-95 in 497 games this season entering the tournament, a winning percentage of .821.
- Session four features four teams with a combined 108-23 record, the most wins by any four teams in the opening session. Session one and three each features four teams with 100 wins while session two has four teams with a combined 94 wins.
- Only one first round game features teams that have both compiled 27 wins or more. Butler (27-4) will meet Perry County Central (27-3).
- Rockcastle County's 32-1 record is the best of any team in 2011 field.
- Five teams are in the tournament in consecutive seasons.

TOURNAMENT NOTES

Many Looking To Build Sweet 16 Tradition With First Tournament Win

Eight teams will have the chance to post their first win in program history in the state tournament in 2011. Six of the eight first round games feature teams that are looking for their first state tournament win.

Only five teams in the tournament field have more than one tournament win in their history.

E.A. Diddle Arena Plays Host to State Tournament for 11th Consecutive Year

For the 11th consecutive season, E.A. Diddle Arena on the campus of Western Kentucky University in Bowling Green plays host to the girls state tournament. It marks the 18th time the venue has been held at the venue since its opening.

Media credentials are non-transferable. Media members allowing children, students, acquaintances or non-working media members to utilize these passes will lose all media privileges to cover KHSAA events in the future.

PHOTO GUIDELINES

All still photographers/videographers must utilize the marked areas in the end zones and the sideline adjacent to press row from the bottom of the foul circle to the baseline. Photographers/videographers must stay seated on the floor. Please stay off the playing floor during timeouts. Team bench areas are off limits at all times.

No photographers may take photographs from the press row seating.

No tripods are to be used in the arena during the games. Any use must be approved by Elden May, KHSAA Sports Information Director. Anyone wishing to attach a camera to the goal post MUST have prior approval from the KHSAA and Diddle Arena.

No "flash" cameras may be used on floor level.

Television "live shots" are to be conducted prior to or at the conclusion of each session. **ABSOLUTELY NO MERCURY LIGHTS ARE TO BE POINTED IN THE DIRECTION OF THE PLAYING FLOOR FROM ANYWHERE WITHIN THE ARENA WHILE PLAY IS IN PROGRESS.**

INTERVIEWS

Locker rooms and the back hallway are closed to the media during the tournament. Following a brief cooling off period after each game -- five minutes -- the winning coach and selected players will be escorted to the interview area. The losing coach and players will follow. TV stations wishing to do one-on-one interviews will be afforded the opportunity AFTER the coaches/players visit the media interview room. These should take place outside the player/coach entrance to the interview area.

ABSOLUTELY no interviews, especially radio, are to be conducted on the floor immediately following the conclusion of the game. All coaches/athletes **MUST** report to the interview area prior to doing any post game radio/TV interviews.

WEEKLY PAPERS

Due to space limitations, weekly papers are asked to rotate seating during games involving teams from their coverage area. A reserved press row seat for the entire tournament is not available to weekly media outlets. Four seats on press row will be marked "Weekly Papers". You may sit in these seats during your game, but to accommodate others, we ask that you return to the auxiliary seating during games not involving teams from your coverage area.

NON-ORIGINATING RADIO

Radio stations that are not originating a broadcast of the tournament are to utilize auxiliary press seating located in Section L. If this area is full, seating is

available in the 300 Level Sections. There are no reserved seats for non-originating radio stations on press row.

PARKING

A limited number of parking passes are available on a first-come, first-serve basis for media outlets covering the entire event. Once the surface lot is full, the KHSAA-issued parking pass will admit you to the parking structure next to Diddle Arena.

RESULTS

Results including box score and play-by-play from each game will be available in the media work room. Results will also be available via the KHSAA Web site (www.khsaa.org).

RECORDS

MEDIA WORKROOM/HOSPITALITY

The media workroom is located on floor level behind the main scorer's table. Courtesy phone lines are available to transmit. A light pre-session snack will be served one hour prior to tip-off of the first game of each session. Your credential will admit you to the general hospitality (soda, chips, etc.) located in Auxiliary Gym B on Floor Level of Diddle Arena. This room will be open throughout the tournament.

HALFTIME

Halftime will be 15 minutes for all games. There will be a minimum of 25 minutes between games.

Tournament Coaches Have Connections to Past Sweet 16 Runs

Many coaches in the 2011 Houchens Industries/KHSAA Girls Sweet 16 State Basketball Tournament have connections to past tournaments on both the boys and girls side. Among them (as reported by head coaches at respective schools):

- Walton-Verona coach Cory Miller played in the 1991 boys event for Covington Holy Cross, reaching the state semifinals as the teams starting point guard.

- Marion County coach Trent Milby coached

Marion County in the 2010 girls tournament. Assistant coach Robert Spalding played in the 1992 boys tournament for Marion County. Assistant coach Anthony Epps played in the 1992 and 1993 boys tournaments. Epps was the 1993 MVP on his way to a title. Epps and Spalding were also assistants on the 2010 girls tournament team.

- DuPont Manual coach Stacy Pendleton is making his second appearance in the girls tournament as a head coach. He also led the Crimson to the 2008 tournament. Pendleton was an assistant coach on the 1994-1995 Adair County team that made the boys tournament and an assistant on the 1997-1998 Jeffersontown team that reached the girls tournament. Assistant coach Erin Monfre played in two Wisconsin state tournaments.

- Sheldon Clark coach Darrin Rice was an assistant coach on the 2006 Johnson Central team that reached the state tournament. Rice is also an alum of Johnson Central '86. Assistant coach Robin Newsome previously led Sheldon Clark to multiple state titles.

- Clay County coach James Burchell played in two boys state tournament in 1974 and 1975 for Clay County. Assistant coach Jayme Gilbert played in the 2006 girls event for Clay County.

- Butler coach Larry Just has one state tournament coaching appearance in 2010. Assistant coach Gary Wheeler was an assistant on the 2008 state championship team and has been to the state tournament as an assistant in three of the last four years. Assistant Jenna Hedges played in the state tournament once and was an assistant coach during last years state tournament run.

- Boyd County coach Pete Fraley played on the 1984 boys team that went to the state tournament from Boyd County. He also coached the 2003 girls team that reached the tournament. Assistant Dan Rowsey was an assistant in 2003 while assistants Jennifer Swann and Megan Brown played on the 2003 team.

- Calloway County coach Scott Sivills coached the team to the 2003 and 2007 girls tournaments previously. Assistant coach Chelsea Futrell was a freshman on the 2003 team that reached the tournament.

- Rockcastle County coach Chrysti Noble has coached the Rockets in every state tournament game that they have played. Assistant coach

Johnna Abney played for Noble in 2004 and 2005 when the Rockets reached the tournament. Abney also played in the Kentucky All-Star game in E. A. Diddle Arena in the summer of 2005.

- Bowling Green's LaVonda Johnson reached the state tournament as a player at Warren East. Assistant coach Greg Johnson also played in the tournament.

Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony Quickly Approaching

The induction ceremony for the 2011 class to the Dawahares/KHSAA Hall of Fame is quickly approaching. The ceremony is scheduled for April 16, 2011. The 2011 class features 13 members, including Sweet 16 legend J.R. VanHoose, a boys' basketball star from Paintsville.

Members of the 2011 induction class are:

Leonard Carpenter – One of the most prolific scorers in Kentucky basketball history, Carpenter scored 3,003 career points at Salyersville High School. At the time of his graduation, Carpenter was the first player in state history to achieve the mark.

Kristie Combs – An outstanding basketball player for M.C. Napier High School, Combs set several state records during her career. Combs finished her career with 2,792 points and 586 assists. She led the Lady Navajos to the 1994 state championship, winning the tournament most valuable player award in the process.

Gladys Coomes Thompson – A member of the 1927 girls state basketball champion West Louisville squad, the Daviess County native never lost her love for basketball. Her pioneering spirit made female athletics in Kentucky the experience it is for generations of student-athletes.

Tim Cooper – Cooper finished his high school career at St. Xavier in 1970 with a 123-0 record and four consecutive individual state tennis championships. He was also an all-district, all-region and all-state performer in basketball.

Mike Deaton – An all-state athlete in two sports as well as a state champion hurdler, Deaton was awarded 18 letters at Green County High School for football, baseball and track. He was also named a scholastic All-American in football.

Earl V. Driskell Jr. – Driskell has enjoyed more than seven decades in athletics as a coach and official. In addition to coaching for 35 years at four

different schools, Driskell continues in his seventh decade as an official in a career that began in the late 1940s and includes numerous awards.

Beth Wilkerson Hammond – A gifted basketball player, Wilkerson excelled for Paris High School, leading the school to a state runner-up finish in 1977. Her individual accomplishments include a 20-point and 11-rebound per game average, 1,600 career points, Parade First-Team All-American, 1979 Miss Basketball and a distinguished collegiate career at Old Dominion.

Gary Kidwell – A longtime supporter of high school athletics in northeastern Kentucky, Kidwell served as basketball coach at Lewis County High School for 20 years, baseball coach for 12 and football coach for 10, as well as athletic director for nearly two decades. Kidwell also is a longtime baseball and softball umpire and served on the KHSAA Board of Control, in addition to Commissioner of the Eastern Kentucky Conference since 2001. Kidwell has served as sports editor of the Lewis County Herald since 1975 and continues to host a weekly sports show on WKKS radio in Vanceburg after 35 years.

Richard "Dick" Morse – His outstanding four-sport officiating career began in 1960 with baseball and basketball and continued to football, where Morse called 30 playoff games. In 1995, Morse was named the Kentucky Official of the Year and in 2002 was awarded Supervisor of the Year.

Felton Spencer – A standout at Eastern High School in the mid-1980s, Spencer helped the Eagles to a pair of 7th Region championships and a spot on the Kentucky-Indiana All-Star Team in 1986. He followed with a standout career at the University of Louisville, followed by a lengthy NBA career.

Joey Stockton – A nine-time state track champion and Kentucky Mr. Football finalist, Stockton excelled at North Hardin High School. He was named Mr. Track in back-to-back years as well as Kentucky Male Athlete of the Year his senior year in 1993-1994.

J.R. VanHoose – A schoolboy legend at Paintsville High School, VanHoose led the Tigers to the 1996 state championship and a runner-up finish in 1998. VanHoose finished his career with 3,095 points and 2,069 rebounds, one of only a handful of players to accomplish the feat. Among the individual honors bestowed upon VanHoose are Parade All-American, USA and Gatorade Player of the Year and 1998 Kentucky Mr. Basketball. VanHoose also enjoyed a standout career at Marshall University.

Larry Vaught – The sports editor of the Danville Advocate-Messenger for more than three decades, Vaught has spent his entire career promoting and recognizing high school student-athletes that would have otherwise gone unnoticed.
