STATE SOCCER THIS WEEK

The 2007 KHSAA State Soccer Championships will be held Oct. 31, Nov. 1 and Nov. 3 at Toyota Stadium in Georgetown. Boys' semifinals are scheduled for Wednesday with Bowling Green taking on St. Xavier at 6 p.m., followed by George Rogers Clark taking on Lexington Catholic at 8 p.m. Girls' semifinal action is scheduled for Thursday with Sacred Heart taking on Notre Dame at 6 p.m. and then Woodford County taking on Marshall County at 8 p.m.

The Boys' State Championship will be at 6 p.m. on Saturday, Nov. 3. The Girls' State Championship will follow at 8 p.m., also on Nov. 3.

General admission tickets will be \$7 each per night. An all-session ticket will be available for \$15.
