FORCHT BANK/KENTUCKY NATIONAL INSURANCE/KHSAA SPORTSMANSHIP WINNERS ANNOUNCED

A total of 32 student-athletes have been announced as regional winners for the 2012 Forcht Bank/Kentucky National Insurance KHSAA Sportsmanship Awards.

The winners, one boy and one girl from each of the state's 16 regions, will be honored at a banquet, scheduled for Sunday, April 29, at the KHSAA Office in Lexington. Each winner receives a \$200 book scholarship from the folks at Forcht Bank and Kentucky National Insurance, and a recognition award, courtesy of the Officials Division. One boy and one girl, selected as the statewide winner, will receive a one-time \$3,000 scholarship, courtesy of Forcht Bank and Kentucky National Insurance.

Selection criteria for the awards include grade point average, letters of recommendation, leadership roles/honors, response to a case study essay and verification of no game disqualifications.
