D.		 Form GE19 – It is noted that student-athletes are not listed as members of the Gender Equity Review Committee. It is recommended that this oversight be corrected. Forms T-35 & T-36 – Non-applicable is not a way out on the budget report. Like-sports can not be added together. Travel expenses must be included and awards must be listed by sport and not as a mass unit. These forms must be redone and resubmitted by July 15, 2003 The big difference in head baseball/head softball salaries that may require some corrective action. We recommend that the school's Gender Equity Review Committee give a close look at this inequity. The KHSAA will continue to monitor this situation through 2003-2004.
