Notice the three committee meetings were all in one month instead of one in each of the three sports seasons. Forms T-35 & T-36. Written explanation is needed as to why four boys' and four girls' sports have no travel expenses for the 2001-2002 sports seasons. Please submit by July 15, 2003 Forms T-61 & T-3. It is noted that the school does not pass Test 1 or Test 2
	 and that Test 3 might be questionable with so much interest in girls' swimming on the student survey. We advise that the Gender Equity Review Committee take the necessary steps to see if this interest in girls' swimming is real and genuine. Form T-41. Form indicates that in your self-audit your school has discovered that the boys' program has an overall advantage in the areas of equipment and supplies and in coaching. Any time this situation presents itself, Form T-60 should reflect corrective action and that action is not present on your Corrective Action Plan. Please revise and re-submit by July 15, 2003.



- 1) Determine the total number of girls enrolled, (place in Row 1, Column 1). Determine the total number of boys enrolled, (place in Row 2, Column 1).
- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
- Ask the head coaches to review the most updated eligibility or squad lists for their teams.
