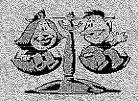

D • •	Other Recommendation and Comments: On Forms T-35 & T-36, although the overall package of total expenditures appears to be in line, there are some glaring differences that need a documented explanation: 1) there is an over \$1,000 difference in boys'/girls' basketball equipment and supplies, 2) there is an almost \$4,000 difference in boys' baseball/girls' softball equipment and supplies, and 3) there is almost a \$1,000 difference in the boys'/girls' golf travel. It was stated to the Gender Equity Review Committee during the school visit that, at times, certain areas would be out of balance (as above).
	 No later than August 2, 2004, school personnel should provide written documentation that explains the large expenditures for boys and compared to girls in the aforementioned areas. Nice job on this year's report!

- 1) Determine the total number of girls enrolled, (place in Row 1, Column 1). Determine the total number of boys enrolled, (place in Row 2, Column 1).
- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
- Ask the head coaches to review the most updated eligibility or squad lists for their teams. Ask coaches to confirm the names of those individuals who are on the team as of the first date of competition, and cross out the names of those who were cut from the team or quit the team prior to the first competitive event. Note: While being within three percent is <u>not</u> a formal compliance standard; if the percent listed in Row 1, Column 4 is within 3% of Row 1, Column 2, then it provides a good target within which compliance is likely.
