The Gender Equity Review Committee should review this matter.  The school has addressed the advantage the boys' program has in locker room space in the Corrective Action Plan.  It was not clear to the auditor why only 235 students were surveyed since the school has an enrollment of 878. Students in grades 8-11 should be included in the survey.
