Based on information provided in the Annual Report, \$477 is spent per individual male athlete and \$336 is spent per individual female athlete. This appears to be a disparity in terms of the amount of money expended for males as compared to females. On Form T-41, an advantage was given to the boys' program in the area of "Scheduling of Games and Practice Times". This disparity should be addressed on Form T-60, the Corrective Action Plan, as an "item for correction, suggested change and time table for corrective action". |
