D.		Other Recommendation and Comments: It is recommended that students be placed on the Gender Equity Review Committee, and that they be active members of the Committee. It is recommended that your Gender Equity Review Committee meet at least once during the fall sports season, once during the winter sports season and once during the spring sports season. On Form T-41, school personnel have indicated an advantage to the boys program in the area of Locker Rooms, Practice and Competitive Facilities. The Corrective Action Plan addresses the need for a volleyball locker room. The Gender Equity Review Committee should review this and decide if this one improvement will then equalize the boys' and girls' programs. If not, then this should be addressed on next year's Corrective Action Plan (Form T-60).
