D.		Other Recommendation and Comments: Form T-3 indicates that there is a sufficient interest in girls' soccer; however, neither Form T-41 nor Form T-60 reflects this interest. Corrective action needs to be addressed to this issue. Form T-1 indicates that the percentage of total participation is 53.9% for boys and 46.1% for girls. On Forms T-35 & T-36, it was indicated that 66% of the total athletic budget was spent on boys as compared to 34% on girls. The Gender Equity Review Committee needs to meet and look at this large difference. The Committee then needs to give an explanation of that difference and corrective action as to how this issue can be brought to a better balance. Please submit a new Form T-60, Corrective Action Plan, to the KHSAA no later than June 15, 2005, which reflects both the issue of girls' soccer and the issue of the athletic budget.

*Number of 8th grade students & below used in Column 3 and Column 4 calculations if applicable:

- 1) Determine the total number of girls enrolled, (place in Row 1, Column 1). Determine the total number of boys enrolled, (place in Row 2, Column 1).
- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
- Ask the head coaches to review the most updated eligibility or squad lists for their teams. Ask coaches to confirm the names of those individuals who are on the team as of the first date of competition, and cross out the names of those who were cut from the team or quit the team prior to the first competitive event. Note: While being within three percent is <u>not</u> a formal compliance standard; if the percent listed in Row 1, Column 4 is within 3% of Row 1, Column 2, then it provides a good target within which compliance is likely.
