According to the data submitted, the school appears to be meeting the standards established in Test # 1 and Test # 2 for Athletic Participation Opportunities. The major area of concern is athletic expenditures. According to the data provided by school personnel, they are currently spending 36.41% of the school's monies on girls' sports (which has 51% of total participants). This spending appears very disproportionate and should be closely monitored by school administrators and the Gender Equity Review Committee.
