The major concern is, according to data provided, the school is not currently meeting the standards established in any of the three tests for Athletic Participation Opportunities (i.e. Forms T-1, T-2 & T-3). The failure to meet these standards is not indicated on the school's Form T-41, but there does appear to be some attempt in the Corrective Action Plan (Form T-60) to address the issue. It would appear, based on the number of sports already offered, that the school is very close to meeting the standards established in Test # 3. It is recommended that your Gender Equity Review Committee meet at least once during the fall sports season, once during the winter sports season and once during the spring sports season.
