Mr. Edwards discussed the attempt to have a female volleyball team. Three meetings were held and had good response the first meeting, but the final two meetings students changed their minds. We will have another meeting this spring in an attempt to field a team.

Mr. Edwards said the K.H.S.A.A. said we have a lack of female participation in sports. WE must look at other avenues to solve this. This matter was discussed and everyone felt volleyball was the way to go. We will try this route again and if it fails we will look elsewhere.

Improvements have been made in the gymnasium, baseball, and softball fields. A scoreboard and lights are needed on the soccer field. This need was discussed, but no action taken. Mr. Edwards said during the basketball season all Friday and Saturday night games are scheduled with the girls playing last, considered prime time. Improvements to the dressing rooms were also discussed. Painting and other recommendations were made.

Student representatives were not there due to basketball practice schedule. No concerns were brought fourth. Work continues on the dugouts on the baseball field. Backstops for the baseball and softball fields are being purchased. The baseball and softball schedules are set as well as the soccer schedule. The volleyball meeting for girls will be held soon to see if there is enough interest to pursue a team. The golf schedule is also in place. Meeting was adjourned. The meeting was advertised at school and on the local radio station and newspaper. Results showed there is some interest but not enough yet to pursue uniforms, coach, and a varsity schedule. Mr. Edwards did suggest that some practice could be held and maybe some scrimmage with local schools. WE will continue to pursue volleyball in accordance with the interest survey. Hickman Co.
