Other Recommendation and Comments: It is recommended that your Gender Equity Review Committee meet at least once during the fall sports season, once during the winter sports season and once during the spring sports season. Inclusion of tennis on Form T-60, Corrective Action Plan, addresses the interest on Form T-3. From the information submitted by school personnel, it appears that the school is not in compliance with any of the three Participation Opportunities Tests. It is close on Test # 1 and Test # 3 and is being addressed on Form T-60. School administrators and the Equity Committee need to find viable ways to improve the Participation Opportunities for girls in sport at Trigg County High School.
