The survey shows there is an interest in swimming for boys and girls. The school is responsible for investigating this interest by having meetings with the interested students and their parents. The school should document the findings after having these meetings and place in the Title IX folder to ensure that all avenues have been researched regarding this interest. The survey does not support the response on T-2 and it appears presently the school is not in compliance with any of the three tests. The Gender Equity Committee and school administration should address this matter and implement a plan of action for correction.
