The KHSAA requires all schools to have three meetings per school year. In the future, expenditures should be recorded for each sport, do not combine expenditures for any sport. Cheerleading should not be included in the athletic budget. The school is spending \$241 more per athlete on male students. The school administration and the Gender Equity Committee needs to examine the expenditures and spending to ensure equity in benefits received by all athletes. Presently, it appears that the boys have an advantage in Support Services. This advantage was not so noted on form T-41. This advantage should also be noted on the school Corrective Action Plan to address this situation. The school stated there were no corrections needed at this time.
