The North Hardin swim program travel expenses are paid for by the board of education. This process is due to the lack of facilities within our district. North Hardin practices and holds meets at the Ft. Knox base.

Our amounts are greater the year in football, girls basketball, and girls softball. This difference is due to our four-year rotation of uniforms.
