D.	X	Other Recommendation and Comments: According to the expenditures submitted the school spent \$292 more per male athlete than on female athletes. The school spent \$225 more per male athlete on the 2005-2006 Annual Report so the spending has not improved, in fact it has increased. The committee needs to address the spending per athlete at the first meeting of the 2007-2008 school year. It is the responsibility of the committee to stress equity in expenditures for all athletes. This advantage that the boys have in spending was not addressed on Form T-41 or the schools Corrective Action Plan Form T-60. The auditor will continue to monitor this area for improvement.

- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).
- Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is female. (Divide Row 1, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 1, Column 2.) Calculate the percentage of total enrollment that is male. (Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
