Comments: According to the results of the latest student survey, the female students were interested in golf. This interest was reflected on the 2005-2006 T-3 form. The school sponsored a girls golf team in the fall of 2006. The return rate for the survey was only 68%. The school must increase that return rate on the next student interest survey to at least an 80%.

The 2006-2007 Revisit forms reflect the school's response to this deficiency. According to the data submitted on the 2006-2007 Revisit forms, it appears the school will meet the standard for test T-3 for the 2006-2007 school year. The school must increase the student interest survey return rate. The Gender Equity Committee should address this problem so the 80% return rate requested by the KHSAA can be achieved on the next student interest survey.
Equipment and Supplies	X		Uniforms and equipment appeared equitable. The spending data submitted on the T-35 and T-36 forms were equitable. The school needs a written uniform purchase and replacement policy that will be followed. This policy should be strictly enforced by school administration. During the interview portion of the Re-visit it was learned that the present policy is not followed by some of the coaches and some of the booster clubs. This practice renders the current policy ineffective and can cause future inequity. A new policy should include solutions for this potential problem.
Scheduling of Games and Practice Time	X		Prime dates are 50% for the 2006-2007 season. This exceeds the 40% required by the KHSAA. Prime time is satisfactory, and practice times are equivalent.
Travel and Per Diem Allowances	X		Madison Central High School has regulations for travel and per diem which are not in a written policy. They need to be redone into policy form

Coach	ning	X	Coaching salaries are equivalent and coaches are equally accessible to athletes.
Pract	er Rooms, ice and petitive ties	X	Madison Central High School is undergoing a massive renovation and 2008 is the expected date of completion. All athletic areas appear improved from the initial visit in 2000. During the 2000 visit a difference between the boys and girls basketball locker rooms was noted. The renovation has equalized the boys and girls locker rooms. There are two sets of washers and dryers. One set is used by football and the second set is available to all other sports. The school should have a written locker room/dressing room assignment for each sport. The indoor and outdoor facilities are equitable with the exception of the softball field. The softball outfield fence is portable and according to school officials the fence is taken down after the softball season and the outfield becomes part of the practice football field. This practice can lead to damage to the outfield surface and become an inequity between the softball and baseball facilities. School administration and the Gender Equity Committee should approach this possibility in two ways; they should physically inspect the softball outfield before, during, and after football's spring, summer, and fall practices noting any irregularity in the outfield surface, and they should make plans for moving the practice football area in the event any damage to the softball field does occurred.

The weight room usage schedule is posted.  Madison Central High School has two cheerleading squads, pep band, color guard, and dance team. They are performing equally for the boys and girls varsity and junior varsity
Support Services	X	At this time there are 9 booster clubs at Madison Central High School. Some of the clubs have in school accounts and others do not. During the Re-visit it was learned that the athletic director does not approve booster club spending. At this time the T-35 and T-36 budget forms show equitable spending. This could change into an inequity without spending approval. It is recommended that school administration review current methods of spending oversight so that the possibility of future spending inequities do not occur.

# 5. Brief Summary/Analysis of the Corrective Action Plan (Form T-60)

The school's 2005-2006 Corrective Action Plan addressed band playing at an equal number of boys and girls games, and in an effort to control spending, setting up a uniform replacement account. During the Gender Equity Committee meeting corrective action plans and future plans were discussed.

#### 6. Observed Deficiencies in Overall Girls and Boys Athletics Programs

Madison Central High School did not meet any of the opportunity tests for the 2005-2006 school year. The 2006-2007 Re-visit forms show the school responded to the Student Interest Survey by adding a girls golf team during the fall of 2006. This addition should change the test T-3. In so doing the school should be able to meet the standard for test T-3 on the 2006-2007 Annual Audit Report.

The following are not deficiencies but must be completed:

- 1. Submit to the KHSAA, no later than March 1, 2007 a copy of an adopted policy regarding a uniform replacement schedule for all teams that participate in athletics at your high school. A copy of this intended replacement and review process must be provided to all head coaches and must be placed in your school's Master Title IX File.
- 2. Submit to the KHSAA, no later than March 1, 2007 a copy of an adopted school wide policy that addresses equitable travel and per diem allowances for both male and female sports. A copy of this policy must be distributed to all head coaches and a copy must be maintained in your school's Master Title IX File.
- 3. Submit to the KHSAA no later than March 1, 2007 a copy of a written agreement between your high school and related booster organizations stating that your high school's administration will oversee all expenditures, whatever the source, which provides benefits of any nature to your high school's athletes and athletic teams. A generic draft of a booster club agreement is offered for your review on the KHSAA website ("Links, Reports and Information").

Even though Madison Central High School's renovation is not complete, the athletic facilities are impressive. It is obvious the school and community are proud of its athletic program, and understands the benefits from athletic competition. The school should request a copy of the 1999-2000 Baseline Report from the KHSAA office and place that copy and copies of the requested polices in the school's permanent Title IX file. It is suggested that the file be organized and kept in a binder. This will make it easier and less time consuming for those interested in viewing the information. The Gender Equity Committee should pursue methods for increasing the return rate on the Student Interest Survey, and assist in all requested polices. At this time spending has been equitable but the need for administrative oversight is crucial for continued equity.

The District Title IX Coordinator should be a member of the Gender Equity Committee.

Madison Central has attempted to offer girls golf on the JV level and according to surveys had enough to play until the time to participate and then they decided not to play.

You will find enclosed the policies pertaining to 1. Uniform Replacement and a schedule of when those will be replaced, 2. Travel per diem policy, 3. Athletic booster agreements are in place, 4. Locker room assignments are distributed and 5. Softball field use and maintenance policy is in place. It is our desire to make everything equitable between our girls and boys and we realize the difficulty of the task at hand. However at Madison Central we are planning on total equality.

We hope that with the current issues revealed by the audit team that we are in the process of attaining that goal and that the action taken by the school will help us accomplish the task.

#### Policy for use & Maintenance of Softball Field

- 1. Fence will be put up in the spring and taken down in the fall
  - A. Fence cap will be installed when fence is up
  - B. Fence will be stored on the softball infield
- 2. Grass part of the softball field will be monitored for wear and abuse during the fall football practice season (<u>freshman only practice there</u>)
- 3. If wear is apparent the field will be rolled and reseeded in the fall to ready for spring softball
  - A. Field will be plugged for aeration At the end of football season
  - B. Field will be seeded in the fall and reseeded in the spring if necessary
  - C. Field will be dragged and plugs distributed for field smoothing at the end of football season
  - D. Field will be rolled for smoothness if needed in the spring prior to February 15 or as soon after February 15 as weather permits
- 4. Field will be maintained to high standards to prevent injuries and bad appearances.
- 5. Mowing of the softball field will start in early March to ensure smoothness and uniformity.

# **Uniform Replacement Policy**

- 1. Team uniforms shall be replaced once every five years.
- 2. If uniforms are damaged, coaches may use money from the sport's allotted budget to purchase replacement uniforms or parts of the uniform.
- 3. Boosters shall no longer purchase uniforms, due to compliance with Title IX guidelines.
- 4. All uniforms shall be ordered through the Madison Central High School Athletic Director following purchasing procedures.
- 5. Quality and equity shall be considered when ordering new team uniforms. Every effort will be made to order the same brand and specifications as requested by the coach.

The Booster Club furthers agrees to refrain from engaging in any activity which, in the opinion of the principal or athletic direct of Madison Central High School or the Superintendent of Madison County Public Schools, adversely affect the school's or the Board's ability to comply with Title IX.

- 3. The Booster Club shall, on or before October 15, 20 (for the 20  $\bigcirc$  20  $\bigcirc$  school year), and August 15, 20  $\bigcirc$  (for the 20  $\bigcirc$  school year), designate a representative for purposes of communicating with and providing true and accurate information to the Board and Madison Central High School.
- 4. Upon request of the principal or athletic direct of Madison Central High School, or upon request of the Superintendent of the Madison County Public Schools, the Booster Club shall make available a full and complete list of its members.
- of the Kentucky Administrative Regulations, Chapter 3:30 (internal accounting, and all other relevant statutes and regulations, the Booster Club shall, upon request of the principal or athletic director of Madison Central High School, or on the request of the Superintendent of the Madison County Public Schools, provide a full and complete accounting of all monies raised, as well as a full and complete accounting of all monies expended. In addition, if requested to do so, the Booster Club shall also provide audited financial records concerning its activities.
- 6. On or before December 15,  $20 \ 0 \ 0$  (for the  $20 \ 0 \ 0$   $20 \ 0 \ 0$  school year), and September 30,  $20 \ 0$  (for the  $20 \ 0 \ 0$   $20 \ 0 \ 0$  school year), the Booster Club shall advise the principal and athletic director of Madison Central High Schools of all fund raising activities planned for the upcoming year. To the extent that Booster Club seeks to engage in additional fund raising activities, it shall give at least \_\_\_\_ days notice of the intended activity.

The principal and athletic director of Madison Central High School and the Superintendent of the Madison County Public Schools expressly reserve the right to reject and fund raising activity for any reason. The Booster Club agrees that it shall not engage in any fund raising activity which has not been approved or which has been rejected by the principal or athletic director of Madison Central High School or the Superintendent of Madison County Public Schools.
- 8. By executing this document through its designated representative, all members, officers, and representatives of Booster
