- 2) Add the total number of girls and boys enrolled to determine total enrollment, (place in Row 3, Column 1).

(Divide Row 2, Column 1 by Row 3, Column 1 and place in Row 2, Column 2.) Note: Row 1, Column 2 plus Row 2, Column 2 should total 100%.
- Ask the head coaches to review the most updated eligibility or squad lists for their teams.
