Problem: I'm trying to determine who changed the report since it was signed by the Superintendent and Board Chair. The individual students swim for their respective school. Clearly whoever changed the report was uninformed about the situation in Warren County. In addition, Warren East had their first college scholarship for swimming awarded this year - to a female.
